

Pick-Up Time Is 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM: If you can't be there by 7:00, please call the site (*not the farm*) and let them know when to expect you. Site hosts will let you know what is acceptable. Please respect their wishes. If you do not pick up your produce or call the site, it will be donated early Friday morning. If you are unable to pick up your food (i.e.: you're on vacation), a friend or neighbor is welcome to pick it up instead; but you must give them clear directions regarding the pick up process!

Every-Other-Week Standard Share Members:

Some of you will begin pick-ups on June 12th and others on June 19th; we alternate pickup weeks by sites. If you want to be on the opposite week, you can change your site by notifying us. Since you need to remember which week is your week, please mark your calendars or whatever method works for you. There is a separate check-off sheet at your site for every-other-week members; if it is not there, it is not your week.

Your produce is delivered in a Plastic Container

Here is the routine:

1. Plastic containers and lids **DO NOT** go home with you.
2. Empty the contents of the container into a bag that you have brought with you; extra bags will be at sites if you forget to bring one. (sites will accept donations of full sized, neatly folded paper bags)
3. Neatly stack the containers and lids (the lids do stack!) in a designated area at your site.
4. Large Share and Every-Other-Week Share containers will be labeled. Standard Share containers will have no label. Each type of share will be in its own stack.
5. *Cross off your name* on the check-off sheet when you pick up your box. One last name will be listed for each share.

Share Splitters: If you are splitting a share with another household and dividing the food at the site; clearly mark the partially filled container and set it away from the main pile for the other party to pick up. There will be masking tape and a marker supplied. Do not write on the container.

Farm News: Each week there will be a piece of paper titled “**This Week’s Harvest**” discussing the produce in your share. One copy will be in each container; extra copies will be at each site for people who split the Share. We write a full **newsletter** every other week and send it via e-mail. (If you don’t receive one from us, we don’t have your e-mail address; please send it to us). We also leave newsletters at the sites for people who do not have an e-mail address. The newsletter gives you information about upcoming farm festivals, what’s happening on the farm, pictures and all kinds of other good stuff.

Recipes: Recipes will be posted on our website each week. We usually list the recipes on “This Week’s Harvest” flier that’s in the container. Room permitting, there may be a recipe on the flier as well. We highly recommend the book “**From Asparagus to Zucchini**” for understanding and preparing your produce. If you have already paid for the book we will bring it to your site on your first delivery week. You can order one from us for \$15.

Eggs and Cheese: Egg and Cheese Share members will get a mailing from Dreamfarm. Questions regarding your egg or cheese share should go to Dreamfarm (767-3442) or diana@dreamfarm.biz
